

Outcome and Action Points

OUTCOMES	ACTIONS

STAR points are awarded for "outcomes" and for "actions." Outcome points are given for reaching a level of measurable success. Actions are awarded for activities that focus on moving toward sustainable levels.

Iowa City was awarded 52% of points for outcomes and 48% points for actions. These actions and outcomes show a high level of achievement sustainability.
