




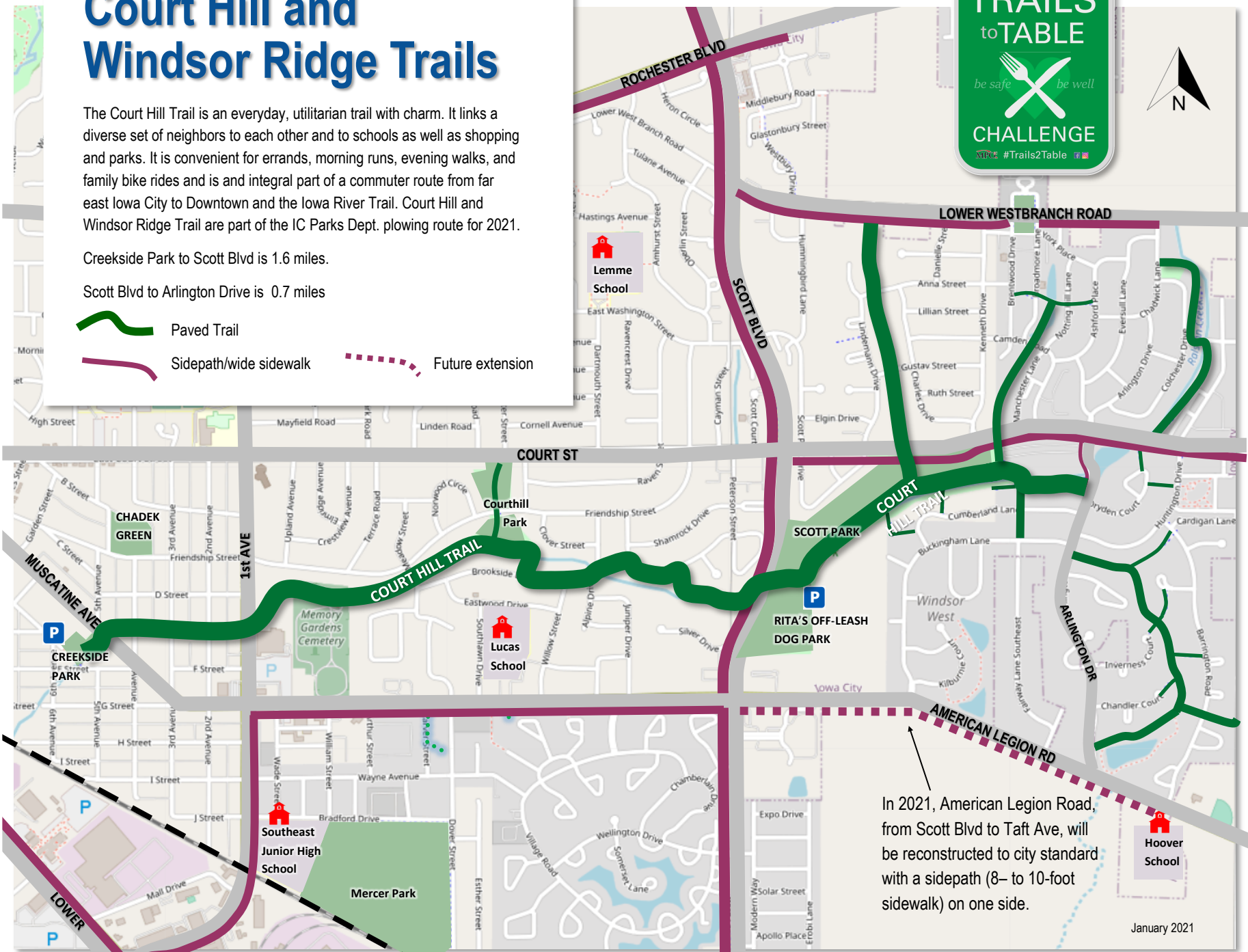
Court Hill and Windsor Ridge Trails

The Court Hill Trail is an everyday, utilitarian trail with charm. It links a diverse set of neighbors to each other and to schools as well as shopping and parks. It is convenient for errands, morning runs, evening walks, and family bike rides and is an integral part of a commuter route from far east Iowa City to Downtown and the Iowa River Trail.
